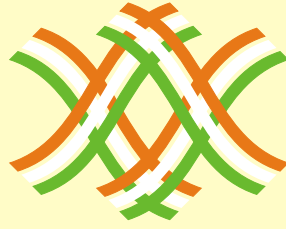


**3rd National Conference**



## **HOMELAND SECURITY A Determined Approach**

### **INTRODUCTION**

The 3rd National Conference on “Homeland Security-A Determined Approach” was jointly organized by the Central Association of Private Security Industry (CAPSI) and the Association of Private Detectives and Investigators (APDI) on the 13&14 October 2008 at the hotel, The Grand Ashok, Bengaluru. The Conference was inaugurated by Lt. Gen. Rajender Singh, SM, VSM, Director General-Infantry, Indian Army by lighting the lamp along with H H Maharaja Bhanu Prakash Singh of Narsingharh, Former Union Minister & Governor and Chief Patron of CAPSI & APDI, Kunwar Vikram Singh, Chairmam CAPSI & APDI and other dignitaries. # OBJECTIVES OF THE CONFERENCE

## The Conference aimed at:-

- To offer the support of 55 lakhs private security force to the Government of India as an effective force multiplier in gathering of the intelligence and their gainful utilization in the maintenance of the Law & Order and to be a catalyst for the Homeland Security and Disaster Management.
- To create awareness amongst security agencies across the nation, about the States, which have promulgated the PSAR Acts and are having control systems in place through the Controlling Authorities, nominated by the respective States.
- To acquaint the private investigation agencies in India with the clauses of the Private Detective Agencies (Regulation) Bill 2007, pending in the Parliament.
- To bring awareness amongst end-users of their responsibilities towards the service providers with specific reference to the implications that the PSAR Act and proposed PDAR Bill will have on them.
- To keep the participants abreast with the national & international developments related to the Security & Intelligence Industries through the presentations from the national & international icons of these industries.
- To bring certain apprehensions of the Industry to the notice of the Government to cope up with the legal requirements.
- To stress the need of training and future requirements of the Security & Intelligence Industries.
- To highlight that the security and investigation industry are the major employment generators in the Country and in the process trying to bring people, especially in rural areas above poverty line by getting them employed with them.
- To provide the platform and the environment for net working with in the Captains of the Industries and with the government machinery during the two days of deliberations of the National Conference.
- To apprise the members of the CAPSI & APDI and other participants, Guest of Honors and the Chief guests about the activities that have taken place at the central secretariat during the period between the 2nd & 3rd National Conference.


